13 GENERAL ORDER SUPPLEMENTING AND MODIFYING THE COURT'S GENERAL

17 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the
18 October 31, 2019 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
19 Judicial Council of California (attached as Exhibit "A" hereto), issued in response to the
20 October 31, 2019 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of
21 Sonoma County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS;


22 Paragraph (8) of this Court's order dated October 29, 2019 is hereby
23 supplemented and modified as follows:

26 "The Court extends by 11 days the duration of any temporary restraining order
27 that would otherwise expire from October 28, 2019 through November 1, 2019,
28 inclusive, because the emergency condition described in the Order prevented the Court

1 from conducting proceedings to determine whether a permanent order should be
2 entered. All other terms contained in the October 29, 2019 order remain in full force.
3 (Gov. Code, section 68115(a)(7)."

THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Because of an extreme wildfire event, leading to an evacuation order and the forced closure of Sonoma County courthouses, it has been determined that the conditions described in section 68115 of the Government Code are met with regard to the Superior Court of California, County of Sonoma. Due to the effects of unprecedented high-wind events, resulting in fires and evacuations across the state, including in Sonoma County, Governor Gavin Newsom has declared a statewide state of emergency. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Gary Nadler, it is ordered that the Superior Court of Sonoma County is authorized to do the following:

Extend by not more than eleven (11) days the duration of any temporary restraining order that would otherwise expire from October 28, 2019, to November 7, 2019, inclusive, because the emergency condition described herein prevented the court from conducting proceedings to determine whether a permanent order should be entered (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(7)).

This order supplements the order issued on October 28, 2019.
