ORDER

Order of the Presiding Judge

This Order revokes and supersedes the Order of the Presiding Judge concerning COVID-19 matters dated July 16, 2021.

Due to the recent surge in both COVID-19 and the highly contagious Delta Variant of COVID-19, it is necessary to modify prior COVID-19 related Orders for the safety and well-being of all who enter our courthouses.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That all persons entering any Sonoma County Superior Courthouse will be required to wear a compliant face covering at all times which must cover both the nose and mouth completely. Compliant coverings do not include: 1) neck gaiters 2) masks with valves or other holes 3) bandanas or 4) face shields. This Order applies to all interior spaces of each courthouse including courtrooms, public entries and hallways, common areas, and work spaces. This Order applies regardless of vaccination status.
- 2. The Sonoma County Emergency Bail schedule shall remain in effect until further order of the Presiding Judge.
- 3. The Order of the Presiding Judge regarding Courtroom Proceedings via Zoom dated November 12, 2020, shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to any and all remote appearances indefinitely.

- 4. Any judicial officer shall have the authority to order any person removed from the courthouse for failure to follow these orders, or if the judicial officer observes COVID-19-like symptoms.
- 5. This Order shall be effective August 3, 2021.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
