## GOVERNOR APPOINTS TROYE KENDALL SHAFFER AS A JUDGE IN SONOMA COUNTY



Troye Kendall Shaffer, 47, of Windsor, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the Sonoma County Superior Court. She has served as a Commissioner at the Sonoma County Superior Court since 2019. She served as Chief Deputy District Attorney at the Sonoma County District Attorney's Office from 2015 to 2019, where she was a Deputy District Attorney from 2000 to 2015. Judge Shaffer was an Associate at Bowles and Verna LLP from 2000 to 2001. She earned a Juris Doctor degree from the University of California, Hastings College of the Law. Judge Shaffer fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Robert S. Boyd.
